HISTORY

In 2007, a North Carolina Department of Commerce grant made possible the formation of the Piedmont Triad Allied Health Regional Skills Partnership (Partnership), to alleviate the allied healthcare workforce shortage. The Partnership began with 18 members, including the eight community colleges who submitted the regional grant on behalf of TriadWorks and the Piedmont Triad Partnership (PTP). In 2009, the Partnership became Piedmont Alliance for Triad Healthcare (PATH). PATH is employer-driven, with healthcare employers holding the majority of membership allocations in PATH.

VISION

PATH serves as a collaborative advisory council to advocate for and further develop the healthcare workforce to meet the current and emerging needs of healthcare employers in the Piedmont Triad region of North Carolina.
